UNH Master of Public Health (MPH) Program

MPH

- Competency-based degree program framed around core public health fundamentals
- Program targets working professionals such as clinicians, health officers, community and environmental health workers, health and healthcare program managers
- MPH is accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH)
- MPH Program and Franklin Pierce Law Center's Institute for Health, Law, & Ethics also offer a separate graduate certificate in Health Policy and the Law

MPH Curriculum

- 48 credit curriculum
- Nine required core courses
 - Public Health Care System
 - Epidemiology
 - Environmental Health
 - Biostatistics
 - Social & Behavioral Health
 - Public Health Administration
 - Public Health Finance
 - Public Health Ethics
 - Public Health Policy
- Five approved electives
- One field study
- One integrating seminar

MPH Admissions Criteria

- GRE scores are not required, but those who have taken it are invited to submit their score
